Assessing your governance arrangements using our *NFP Diagnostic Tool* provides assurance that your board is considering each Principle in full and at the level of detail required to identify areas for the board's attention and action. It offers your organisation's members, customers, funders, employees and other stakeholders the confidence that the board has a demonstrated commitment to benchmarking and achieving best-practice governance.

Above all, it gives your board the information it needs to focus on specific areas of strength and weakness that will have the most impact on performance and outcomes over time.

What can you expect?

The *NFP Diagnostic Tool* starts with each member of the board and executive team completing an online survey. The questions are designed to assess the application of each Principle to your organisation’s particular circumstances. Results are then compiled into a report.

In addition, a facilitated workshop to discuss the findings and develop a roadmap for improvement also forms part of the AICD’s extended services
